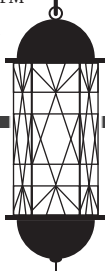

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Oneg vs. Nega

V'Dibartah Bam
(Speaking in Torah)

THE "SEFORIM" WRITE THAT THE LETTERS OF THE word *nega*, as in *nega tzara'as* (a *tzara'as* blemish), when rearranged, can spell *oneg*, as in *oneg Shabbos*, enjoying Shabbos. The letters of the word *tzara'as* can be rearranged to spell *atzeres*, a name used for Yom Tovim, such as Shemini Atzeres and the upcoming Yom Tov of Shavu'os, which is also called Atzeres.

What is the connection? Why should Shabbos and Yom Tov be hinted at in the names for blemishes of impurity, of all places?

The answer is because Shabbos and Yom Tov are the antidotes for and the antithesis of *tzara'as*. *Tzara'as*

comes as a result of sin, of being distant from Hashem, of allowing the material trappings of the world to cover over and hide the deep spiritual essence of the world.

Shabbos and Yom Tov are those days when we stop our regular routines, remove ourselves from the mundane, and place a focus on the true essence of Creation.

As we enjoy this special Shabbos Rosh Chodesh, let's make sure that we experience Shabbos as it's meant to be—a truly spiritual experience, that brings us deep below the surface.
